## 10. SOFT SKILLS DURING NSS REGULAR AND SPECIAL CAMPS

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National Service Scheme is the third dimension of education which allows the youth to actively contribute their service for the cause of community and the nation, thus helping them in their personality development through sharpening their soft skills like leadership, team work, decision making capabilities. NSS Activities are conducted in two ways Regular Activities and Special Camping. These activities are framed to provide enough opportunities for volunteers to expose their hidden talent and capabilities. All the responsibilities are distributed among volunteers by the programme officers. Programme Officers divide volunteers into ten groups for regular activities and in seven groups for special camping. A group leader is appointed in each group. Each group is assigned different duties in rotation like preparing food, execution of physical activity/ technical /cultural sessions, decoration/reception committee, audit, purchase committee etc. to organize any kind of programme or activity. The volunteers are given ample opportunities to participate at distr., state and national level competitions and camps. Every year volunteers of the college are selected for Pre-RD Selection Camps, National Integration camps, NSS Mega camps through a proper selection procedure.
