



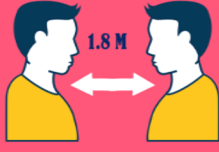

folded closed.

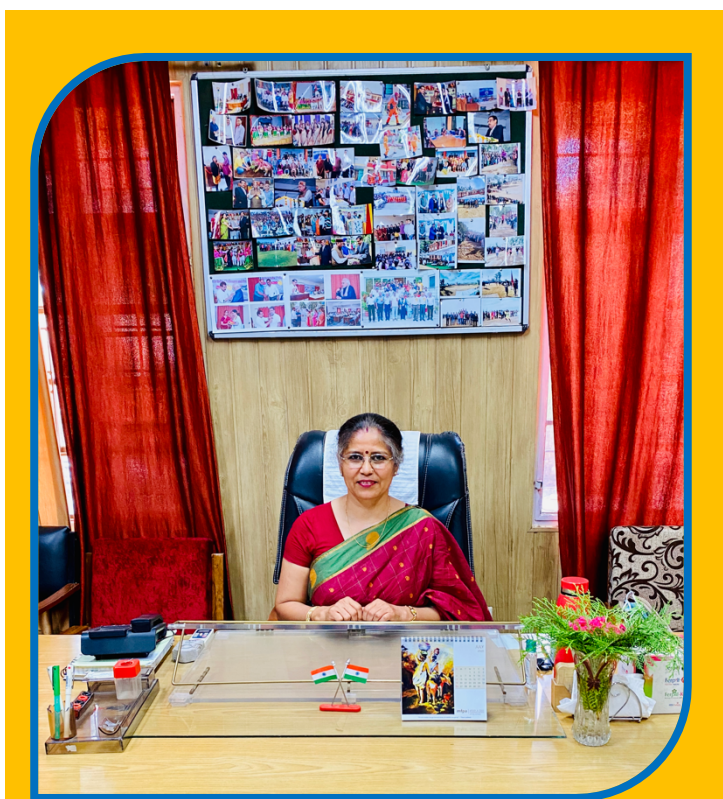


4 Wash your hands.

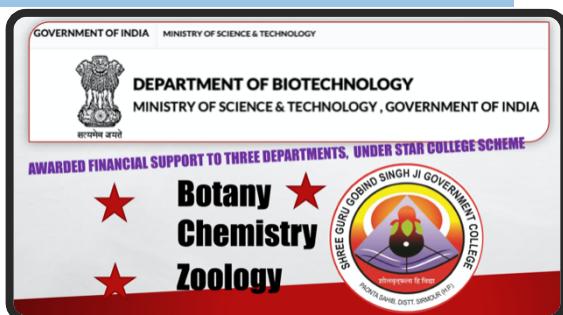


The college campus is spread over in 16 acres of land in village Shubb Khara of Paonta Sahib, about 1.5 KM walkable distance from Bus stand. The college has got the biggest playground in the town. The spacious and fully air-conditioned library is equipped with more than 90,000 books and has digital e-access facility through N-List, funded by UGC as college component under UGCINFONET Digital Library Consortium. The college campus is under CCTV Surveillance, and has Wi-Fi system for online connectivity from any corner of the campus.

The college became a NAAC Accredited Institution and achieved “B+ +” grading for its Quality Oriented Approach and Potential for growth and excellence in the academic session 2016-17. GENERAL ADMISSION RULES

For admission to the *1st Year, a student must not be more than 23 Years (25 Years for girls) of age on 1st July 2020, e.g. the applicant should not be born earlier than 01/07/1997 in case of boys and 01/07/1995 in case of girls.* However, in respect of SC and ST students a relaxation of 3 years is given.

The Vice-Chancellor of HPU Shimla has the power to permit age relaxation up to a maximum of 6 months. All such cases could provisionally be granted age relaxation up to six months by the Principal and a consolidated list of such cases be sent for approval of the Vice-Chancellor. A candidate who has availed age relaxation at the time of first admission shall be eligible for the same in the subsequent classes also.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

The candidate should be passed in the Senior Secondary (+2) Examination (Academic Stream) conducted by the H.P. Board of School Education or an examination accepted as equivalent there to by the various bodies of the H. P. University:

- (1) Provided that the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination with science stream shall be given preference in admission to B.Sc. / B.C.A. program.
- (2) Provided that the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination with commerce stream shall be given preference in admission to B.Com.
- (3) Provided that the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination with mathematics as one of the subjects shall be given preference in admission to B.C.A. program.
- (4) Admission is purely on merit basis. Rounding of fraction of marks is permissible as per norms.

CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS) FOR UNDERGRADUATE COURSES

The Himachal Pradesh University vide Letter No. 2-1/2012 H.P.U. (Academic) dated 4 June 2016 has notified the acceptance of the latest course curriculum under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) brought out by the University Grant Commission for implementation of academic session 2020-21.

OUTLINES OF CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM:

1. Core Course: (12 for general courses; 4 discipline specific papers each for regular courses and 2 papers each for English and Hindi/MIL in B.A./B.Com.

2. Elective Course: Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/ subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill is called an Elective Course.

2.1 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE): (2 each for regular courses): An elective course offered under the main discipline/ subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective.

2.2 Generic Elective (GE) Course: (2 each for B.A./B.Com. regular courses): An elective course chosen from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek exposure beyond discipline/s of choice is called a Generic Elective.

3. Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC): The Ability Enhancement (AE) Courses may be of two kinds: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC). "AECC" courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement; (i) Environmental Science and (ii) English/Hindi/MIL Communication/Sanskrit.

3.1 Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): (4 for regular courses): These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge and should contain both theory and lab/hands-on/training/field work. The main purpose of these courses is to provide students life-skills in hands-on mode so as to increase their employability.

EXAMINATION & EVALUATION SYSTEM

The Evaluation System in CBCS will consist of two components :

(i) Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) accounting for 30% of the final grade that a student gets in a course ; and

(ii) End-Semester Examination (ESE) : accounting for the remaining 70% of the final grade that a student's gets in a course.

(I) Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) : This would have the following components :

(a) Classroom Attendance : Each student will have to attend a minimum of 75% Lectures /Tutorials/ Practical's.

(b) Mid-Term Tests : There will be one mid-term test of 15 marks. It is mandatory to appear in mid-term test & must score 45% marks to become eligible for end-term examination.

(c) Seminar /Assignment :

(i) The 10 marks of the CCE will be awarded on the basis of seminar/assignment etc. that the course teacher might give to the students.

(ii) The remaining 5 marks of the CCE will be awarded on the basis of attendance.

(iii) End-Semester/Examination (ESE) : The remaining 70% of the final grade of the student in a course will be on the basis of end-semester examination (ESE) that will be of three hours duration and covering the whole syllabus of the course.

Duration:

The duration of the PG Courses will be two academic years spread over in four semesters.

Admission Procedure for PG Courses:

The Entrance Tests for admission to the Colleges affiliated to HP University are being conducted by the University in a Centralized Entrance Test for Admission in the subject concerned on the dates mentioned in the HPU Handbook of Information for the Session 2020-21.

Eligibility:

The minimum eligibility for the admission for PG Courses will be governed by H.P. University norms and conditions.

Age Limit:

The upper age limit for Postgraduate Courses is 26 years for boys and 28 years for girls and 29 years in case of SC/ST candidates (both for boys and girls) as on 1st July of the concerned year.

STAR COLLEGE SCHEME

The DBT has accorded the financial support of rupees 63 lakhs for three years to three departments viz. **Botany, Chemistry and Zoology** of this college. Objectives of Star College Scheme:

INDIVIDUAL-SPONSORED SCHOLARSHIPS

Chaudhary Sher Jung Memorial Scholarship: This Scholarship of Rs. 2000/- per student (one girl and one boy student) from each faculty of Arts, Commerce and Science is given to meritorious student coming from economically weaker families to encourage them.

IDENTITY CARD CUM LIBRARY CARD

Identity Card cum Library Card is an important document a student must carry every day. In case of loss of Card, an application to the Principal along with *payment of Rs 20/- duplicate I-Card* will be issued. I-Card cum Library Card should be collected from the Librarian as per schedule notified by the librarian.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

The issuance of the books is between **10:00 AM to 4:00 PM** on all working days. A student must bring his/her library card to get the books issued in his/her name. Only two books are issued to a student at a time for a period of 14 days. **Reference Books/ Dictionaries/ Newspapers/ Periodicals will not be issued.** If the issued books are not returned by due date, a *fine at the rate*

of Rs. 1 per book per day will be charged. Internal damage to a book will invite a fine of Rs. 25/- in addition to recovery of cost of the book. Failure to return the book or to pay the penalty imposed will entail the same procedure for recovery as in the case of recovery of govt. property.

LEAVE RULES

- ⇒ Students should get their leave applications recommended by the teachers.
- ⇒ Leave for 2 days will be sanctioned by the senior tutors / subject teacher.
- ⇒ Leave for 2-5 days will be sanctioned by the Vice-Principal.
- ⇒ Leave for more than 5 days will be sanctioned by the Principal.

RE-ADMISSION

The students **absent for 6 days** continuously from any class without proper sanctioning of leave by the **competent authority of the college**, his/ her name automatically will be struck off from the rolls. A student **absent for 10 days** in a month will also be deleted from rolls.

Re-admission will be entertained on payment of **readmission fee of Rs. 100/-** within **7 days** after duly permitted by the Principal. After expiry of 7 days the student will have to bear a **re-admission fee of Rs. 200/-**. The recommendation of the teacher and in addition to it, the Principal may impose extra fine depending upon the gravity of his/her absence. A student struck off for the second time in a session from any class will be ineligible for re-admission to the class.

CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Education is a very broad term and goes beyond training of one's mind for acquiring textual knowledge. It is associated with other activities in order to see multi-dimensional development of overall personality of a man. The college provides opportunity to our students through many co-curricular and other activities that help them to develop into a sound body and mind. Keeping this in view we have societies like Science Society, Social Science Society, Red Ribbon Club and Eco Club etc. Students are encouraged to join these societies as per their interest. Students can approach the incharge of these societies.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The college has two NSS units. Students have to apply as and when notified through notice board for participation in NSS activities. Interested students may contact NSS Programme officers for enrolment.

ROVERS AND RANGERS

The college has got one unit of Rovers and Rangers each. Basically, it is a voluntary non-political youth organization wherein students are trained to combat during natural disaster and otherwise too. It helps its members to have all-round development and become perfect responsible individuals to the society, nation and the world at large.

COLLEGE STUDENTS CENTRAL ASSOCIATION (CSCA)

The College Students Central Association is formed every year as per the rules laid down by Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla from time to time. Presently the selection for various posts of this association is done through merit i.e. indirect selection mode.

PARENT TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (PTA)

To encourage community participation in education Parent Teachers Association (PTA) under section 2.33 to 2.33.7 of the HP Education Code, 2001, has been established. It is a non-political body for better coordination and interaction between parents and teachers for improvement of academic standards and infrastructural facilities of the college.

SPORTS

It is a bygone story that studies only bring name. Sports have taken many a stride where one can try for a name and fame. In order to encourage students our college provides facilities for indoor and outdoor games. Students are encouraged to participate in any of the games and prepare for inter-college tournaments organized by Himachal Pradesh University to earn name and fame and establish oneself in sports also.

MENTOR CELL

The Students are encouraged to interact with their teachers regarding their problems which may be academic, non-academic or personal. Appropriate help and guidance are provided to cater the needs of students. It is also an essential and integral part of IQAC.

SELF-FINANCING COURSES

Other than routine traditional faculties of Science, Humanities and Commerce the college has thrown open other important courses including BCA and PGDCA to cater to the needs of technologically fast growing society. These self-financing courses are under control of the college level Higher Education Institute Society (Regd.).

BHANUJA: YEARLY PERIODICAL

In order to encourage creative abilities among the students, the college magazine Bhanuja is published annually. It consists of a number of sections and each section has one staff & one student editor. Students are asked to contribute original authored poems, article, stories, memories, experiences and so on giving it a literary tinge. It also exhibits a panoramic summary of year long activities in the form of pictography.

PAHAL: THE CULTURAL FUNCTION

Preservation of cultural heritage gives strength to the society. The society in turn nurtures cultural programs with gusto. Keeping in view the importance of cultural function, college

celebrates cultural festival in the form of a programme called PAHAL with great excitement. This forum provides a platform to students to exhibit their keenness in cultural activities like dancing, singing and various other genres. During this function students prepare cultural activities like dancing singing and various other genres.

IGNOU

IGNOU Study Centre - 1133 G.C. Paonta Sahib is running various educational and vocational programmes. All IGNOU courses are recognized by the Govt. of India & by the UGC. No migration and no age limit is required for IGNOU courses.

DISCIPLINE AND CONDUCT

The Principal has power to take disciplinary action against student indulging in acts of indiscipline, which may lead to ***fine, suspension, rustication or expulsion***.

The following activities will be considered as violative of the college discipline and may result in fine expulsion or rustication depending on the gravity of the offence:

- ⇒ Violence, use of force and ragging.
- ⇒ Making noise and disturbing classes.
- ⇒ Breaking college furniture, doors, windows, etc.
- ⇒ Bringing outsider to the college campus.
- ⇒ Interfering with electrical wiring/appliances.
- ⇒ Writing / defacing walls and blackboards.
- ⇒ Eve-teasing
- ⇒ Smoking, use of *Gutka* or any intoxicant.

Playing Songs/ Music on mobile phones in the campus is strictly prohibited and any violation of this instruction will be considered act of indiscipline.

RAGGING IS A CRIMINAL OFFENCE

Ragging is a punishable offence. Ragging of all kind is strictly banned in the college campus. Anybody caught indulging in this evil exercise shall face penalty under the law. Act remotely suggestive of ragging should be reported to the college authorities/to the member of anti-ragging committee. A student who commits the offence of ragging shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term, which may extend to three years or shall also be liable to a fine, which may extend to Rs. 50,000 or both.

RAGGING

“Ragging includes any type of physical or mental torture inflicted by any individual or group, either by words or conduct which creates an apprehension in the mind of the person that he/she cannot pursue his/her studies free from any mental disturbance or torture created thereby. Any person who aids or abet such an action shall also be guilty of such ragging.”

In order to have zero tolerance and its total elimination from the educational institutions. **Hon'ble Supreme Court of India** vide its orders dated 4th May, 2001; 16th May, 2007 and 11th Feb. 2009 has directed are here as under: Ragging is banned in the institution. Anyone indulging in ragging is liable to be punished appropriately. Punishment shall be exemplary and justifiably harsh. Punishment for ragging includes:

- ⇒ Imprisonment, fine or both.
- ⇒ Expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology.
- ⇒ Withholding scholarship or other benefits.
- ⇒ Debarring from representation in events.
- ⇒ Withholding of results.
- ⇒ Suspension of expulsion from hostel or mess and the like.

रैगिंग
