RAGGING: A PUNISHABLE OFFENCE

(PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 2009)

Defines 'Ragging as doing any act' by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to the student. Such disorderly conduct include, teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do an any act or perform something which such student, will not be willing to do in ordinary course.

Students found accused of such act by the way of indulging in or outside the college premises shall be liable to punishment as per the guidelines given by UGC in the light of Hon'ble Supreme Court directions. The possible punishment shall be anyone or the combination of the following :-

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Suspension/withdrawing of Scholarship and other financial benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in examination and other evaluation process.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any intra-college/inter-college/inter-university/international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Suspension and rustication from the college.
- Cancellation of Admission.
- Special Fine depending upon the gravity of the offence
- Collective Punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of Ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

Note : The cases pertaining to the Ragging will be reported to the police and will be dealt as per Himachal Pradesh Education Institution (Prohibition of Ragging) Act 2009 according to which Ragging has been declared as a 'Cognizable and Non-Bailable Offence'. Any student convicted of Ragging related offence will be punished with the imprisonment of upto 3 years or fine of Rs.50,000 or both.

It is mandatory for all students to fill online Anti- Ragging Declaration. The hard copy or reference number generated has to be submitted along with application form.

About Institution

Established in the year 1994 Shree Guru Gobind Singh Ji Government College Paonta Sahib has earned its name after Shree Guru Gobind Singh Ji, the tenth Sikh guru who sojourned here between 1685- 1689. It is believed that Guru Gobind Ji spent most of his time here meditating and experiencing spiritual bliss. He also wrote many religious books and then went to Anandpur Sahib to establish the Khalsa Panth. The Gurudwara Paonta Sahib houses a museum which contains antiques and weapons used by Guru Gobind Singh during the period spent here.

The college campus is spread over 16 acres of land in village Shubh Khera at a distance of 1.5 km from bus stand. The college has a large, well maintained playground with play zones that provide excellent amenities for sports and other recreational activities. The spacious and fully air conditioned library is equipped with more than 12000 books and has digital accessibility through N-List, funded by UGC as college component under UGC INFONET Digital Library Consortium. The campus is under CCTV surveillance and has Wi-Fi system for online connectivity. The college is affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla and recognised by the University Grants Commission (UGC) of India, New Delhi. The college provides Undergraduate Degree Courses in BA/ BSc/ BCom; Post Graduate Degree Courses in Economics, English, Chemistry, Commerce, Geography, Hindi, Mathematics and Political Science. Apart from this, Self-Financing courses, BCA and PGDCA and Add on course English Employability and Entrepreneurship (EEE) are also available. MBA under Self Financing Course has been proposed to be started from this very session.

A leading premier educational institution of the region, the college is accredited with 'A' grade by NAAC (National Accreditation and Assessment Council) in the second cycle of accreditation in December 2022. It is one of the Utkrisht Mahavidyalayas of the state and was also covered under Star College Scheme in which a grant of rupees 63 lakhs was accorded by DBT, Government of India, to three departments Botany, Chemistry, and Zoology Departments of the college. The overall progress of the college has been graded 'A' on completion of the scheme recently. The college is also likely to receive appreciable amount out of Rs. 10 crores allocated to District Sirmour under Gender Inclusion and Equity Initiative Component of PM-USHA.

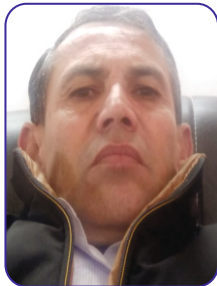

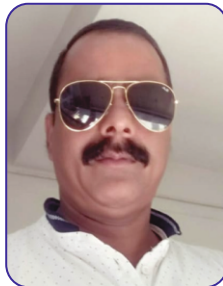

ADMISSION RULES & ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

The minimum qualification prescribed for admission to the courses and examination leading to the degree course of the university shall be in accordance with the first ordinance of HP University 1973 (clause 1.4 Chapter-1) Any student who is seeking admission in the college in any Faculty / Course has to fulfill the following eligibility condition/Rules (clause 3.3A of Chapter III Vol.1) of the Ordinance of HP University.

स्नातक पाठ्यक्रम एवं परीक्षा में प्रवेश पाने के लिए न्यूनतम योग्यता हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय के प्रथम अध्यादेश 1973 (उपधारा 1.4 अध्याय-1) में निर्धारित योग्यता के अनुसार होगी। कोई भी छात्र जो महाविद्यालय के किसी भी संकाय/पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश पाना चाहता है उसे हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय के अध्यादेश (उपधारा 3.3ए अध्याय III खण्ड 1) के अनुसार निम्नलिखित पात्रता शर्त/नियम को पूरा करना होगा।

Students seeking admission in B.A./B.Sc./B.Com 2nd & 3rd year will have to take roll -on admission without waiting for the previous result. However, their admissions shall be purely provisional and subject to the result of previous class.

A. Academic Qualification BA-I-(Pass Course)

To be eligible for seeking admission to B.A.-1 (Pass Course) the candidate should have passed:

- (II) Intermediate examination of Indian University/Board or any examination recognised equivalent thereto (pass in four subjects, one language and three other elective) with atleast 33% marks.

- (III) For admission to BA-I with mathematics, either 45% marks in aggregate (with maths) or 45% in mathematics at 10+2 level, is eligible for admission to BA-1.

B.Com-I (Pass Course)

To be eligible for seeking admission to B.com-I (pass course) the candidate should have passed:

- (I) 10+2 examination (commerce stream) with minimum 40% are eligible for admission in 1st year of the course.

OR

- (II) A student who has passed +2 or equivalent exams other than commerce stream in four written subjects (including English) with Economics or Mathematics as compulsory subject at +2 level with 45% marks is eligible for admission in 1st year of the course.

जिन विद्यार्थियों ने 10+2 अथवा समकक्ष परीक्षा वाणिज्य विषय के साथ नहीं उत्तीर्ण की है, ऐसे विद्यार्थी 10+2 में न्यूनतम 45% कुल अंकों के साथ उत्तीर्ण होने चाहिए, लेकिन इन विद्यार्थियों को अपनी 10+2 परीक्षा अंग्रेजी विषय के साथ अर्थशास्त्र अथवा गणित विषय के साथ उत्तीर्ण होना भी अनिवार्य है।

- (III) For girl candidate the eligibility is pass percentage i.e. 33% छात्राओं के लिए उपरोक्त शर्तों के अतिरिक्त न्यूनतम उत्तीर्ण प्रतिशत 33% है।

B.Sc.-I (Pass Course)

To be eligible for seeking admission to B.Sc.-I (pass course) the candidate should have passed:

- (I) 10+2 examination or an equivalent examination (PCM/PCB) in science from a recognized Board/University established by law in India with five subject (including English) with at least 45% marks.

OR

- (II) Intermediate examination of an Indian University / Board or any examination (PCM/PCB) recognized equivalent thereto (pass in four subjects, one language and three other elective subjects) with minimum 45% marks) is eligible for admission to B.Sc.-I.

किसी मान्यता प्राप्त बोर्ड/विश्वविद्यालय से विज्ञान संकाय में (PCM/PCB) में किसी भाषा सहित चार विषयों में 45% न्यूनतम कुल अंकों के साथ इंटरमीडिएट या समकक्ष।

Remarks :-

While determining percentage of marks for eligibility, rounding off of traction of 0.5 or above to the next full unit is permissible. A relaxation of 5% is available to SC/ST candidates for admission to B.Sc./B.Com 1st year.

Important Note :-

At any stage, if any student is found to claim his/her basic eligibilty qualification from fake or unrecognized Board/University, his/her admission shall stand automatically cancelled. The College shall not be responsible for cancellation of such admissions.

B.C.A. (Under Self-Financing Scheme)

B. Age Limit

For admission to the 1st year of any course a student must not be more than 23 years (25 years for girls) of age as on 1st July 2024 e.g. the applicant should not be born earlier than 01-07-2001 in case of boys and 01-07-1999 in case of girls. However, in r/o SC and ST Students, a relaxation of 3 years is given.

The Vice-Chancellor of HPU Shimla has the power to permit age relaxation up to a maximum of 6 months. All such cases will be granted age relaxation provisionally upto six months by the Principal and a consolidated list of such cases will be sent for approval of the Vice-Chancellor by 31st October of every Academic Year. A candidate who has availed age relaxation at the time of first admission shall be eligible for the same in the subsequent classes also.

किसी भी पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश के लिए अधिकतम आयु सीमा 01 जुलाई 2024 को छात्रवर्ग के लिए 23 वर्ष (छात्रा वर्ग के लिए 25 वर्ष) से अधिक नहीं होनी चाहिए। अर्थात् छात्रों के सन्दर्भ में जन्मतिथि 01.07.1999 तथा छात्राओं के सन्दर्भ में जन्मतिथि 01.07.2001 से पहले की नहीं होनी चाहिए। यद्यपि अनुसूचित जाति व जनजाति के छात्र/छात्राओं को आयु सीमा में 3 वर्ष की छूट है। 6 महीने की अधिकतम आयु सीमा प्रदान करने की छूट की शक्ति उप कुलपति हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय को प्राप्त है। ऐसे सभी विद्यार्थियों को 6 महीने के लिए प्राचार्य द्वारा अस्थायी प्रवेश दिया जाएगा। ऐसे विद्यार्थियों की समेकित सूची प्रत्येक शैक्षणिक वर्ष के 31 अक्टूबर तक हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय के उपकुलपति के अनुमोदन के लिए भेजी जाएगी। जिस विद्यार्थी ने प्रथम प्रवेश के लिए आयु छूट का लाभ उठाया है वह अगली कक्षाओं में भी आयु छूट के लिए पात्र होगा।

Admission Procedure

General Instructions for Students

1. The candidates seeking admission in the college should download the prospectus for various information.
2. All candidates are advised to fill their online admission form on their own mobile phone/laptop, or in the “**Lokmitra Kendra / Cyber Cafe**” nearby their hometown.
3. All the candidates are directed to register with their **personal mobile number, and email address**, as all the future communication will be done by the admission committees using these mobile number and email address only.
4. Candidate must save the “**Username and Password**” generated during registration process with them, and complete the admission process by filling the online application form using their **own username and password** from “**Login to Apply**” button.
5. Candidate needs to fill the online admission form using his/her own credentials, after that only his/her candidature will be considered for admission. **Registration alone does not make any candidate eligible for admission.**
6. During online filling of application form you need to enter all information correctly, and only upload the “**scanned copy of original documents**” and pay an amount of registration fee if applicable. Only after paying Registration fee the candidate will finally be able to submit the application form if registration fee is required there. You must have to submit your Form to complete registration process.
7. **Photostat copies of documents are not accepted.** If admission committee found any uploaded photostat copy at the time of form verification then their admission form will be rejected, and candidates needs to rectify the rejected form from his/her account, and **resubmit** it again.
8. At the time of form verification admission committee holds all the rights to reject any uploaded documents, if documents are not uploaded in the prescribed format mentioned in the instructions provided at the time of documents upload. Then student will be communicated by the committee through “**SMS and Email**” in their registered mobile number and email address to do the needful changes.
9. Candidate then needs to make the corrections by Logging in their account using their username and password and resubmit the form again and wait for final approval which will be intimated through **SMS and Email within a week.**
10. After final approval from admission committee candidate will be informed by his/her respective committee **to pay the fee through SMS and Email** in their register mobile number and email address.
11. Candidate need to pay the fee online to complete the admission process by logging in their account using his/her own username and password.
12. In case of any query related to online admission, candidate can contact concerned admission committee.

Important Instructions for Filling the Form

Furnishing of false information or suppression of any material fact(s) in the Online Application form(s) would render immediate disqualification of the Applicant(s).

- 4) In **Education** section you must have to add your marks details by clicking on **Add %** Button. A popup window will appear to fill marks details. Enter your marks details in textbox. If you passed under **CGPA** select Yes option and add your grade point, for your help CGPA grade table is there. After filling details select click **Calculate** Button then Press **Save** button.
- 5) In Sub-categories and Activities section select appropriate applicable option.
 - a) Press save to application and move to next page to upload the scanned copy of original documents in the desired columns as per the format given below:
 - b) Only file types - jpg, jpeg, png and pdf of size 500KB are supported.
 - c) Upload recent and clear photographs/documents.
 - d) Your photo should be of passport size in jpeg/png format with minimum dimensions as 200 x 200 pixels and your face should be clearly visible.
 - e) In case you don't have certificate for a selected category just go back, unselect that category and save the form.
 - f) After uploading, you may also upload again if required.
 - g) Documents uploaded will be examined by Admission Committee. You may receive remarks for any modification/update.
 - h) Click on "**Next**" button.
- 6) Here check all the documents if they were uploaded correctly or not. You can also upload any document again if it was not uploaded correctly. After checking click on "**Next**" button.

- 7) Here in this page check all the details filled by you in the form; you can edit any column here if data is not filled correctly. After checking check all the boxes in the check list, and click on **“Continue”** button and pay the registration Fee if applicable otherwise you can directly submit the form. Once your payment confirmation comes your form will be automatically get submitted.
- 8) If due to some reason your registration fee payment stuck or deducted or you didn't see Form Submission confirmation page you must have to try payment again on main page. If payment already in process you can Verify the payment by clicking on **Verify Payment** button.
- 9) After this your form will be submitted. You are advised to download the copy of submitted form for future reference.
- 10) Now the admission committee will verify the application form. In case of any discrepancy found in the online admission form, it will be communicated to the student by **SMS** and **Email** in the registered mobile number and email address provided by candidate at the time of registration.

Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for Undergraduate (UG) Courses

The Himachal Pradesh University Vide Letter No. 2-1/2022 हि.प्र.वि (से) dated 4 June 2016 has notified the acceptance of the latest course curriculum under Choice Based Credit system CBCS brought out by the University Grants Commission for implementation from the 2016-17 academic session. With effect from academic session 2018-19, the semester system in the under graduate classes has been replaced by the annual system without any change in the existing structure of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) under Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA).

Basic Outline of Choice Based Credit System

1. **Core Courses (DSC) :** 12 courses for regular including 2 papers each for English and Hindi/Modern Indian Languages (MIL) in B.A./B.Com.
2. **Elective Course :**
 - 2.1 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course : 1 honours courses and 2 each for regular courses. Elective courses offered under the main discipline/Subject of Study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective.
 - 2.2 Generic Elective (GE) Course : 4 for honours courses and 2 each for B.A./B.Com. Regular courses. An elective course chosen from an unrelated discipline/Subject, with an intention to seek exposure beyond discipline/s of choice is called a Generic elective. A core course offered in a discipline/Subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/subject and vice versa and such electives may also be referred as Generic Elective.
3. **Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) :** The Ability Enhancement (AE) Courses may be of two kinds :
 - 3.1 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) : AECC Courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to knowledge enhancement; I. Environment Science and II. English/Hindi/MIL Communication. These are mandatory for all disciplines.
 - 3.2 Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) :

These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value based and / or skill based knowledge and should contain both theory and lab/hands-on/training/field work. The main purpose of these courses is to provide students life-skills in hands-on mode so as to increase their employability.
4. **Practical/Tutorials :** One each with every core and discipline/generic specific elective paper.

Course Wise Assessment and Evaluation of Students

All Courses involve an evaluation system of students that has following two components :

Note : A student will have to pass both the components (i.e. CCA and ESE) separately with 40% marks in each to become eligible to be declared successful in a course.

- a. Mid -Term (मध्यावधि परीक्षा) Maximum Marks -15 (अधिकतम अंक 15)
Mid- Term Test will be conducted by the college
- b. Seminar /Assignment (संगोष्ठी/सत्रीय कार्य) Maximum Marks -10 (अधिकतम अंक 10)
- c. Attendance Minimum requirement 75% (कक्षा उपस्थिति न्यूनतम सीमा 75 प्रतिशत)
Maximum Marks -05 (अधिकतम अंक 5)

SCHOLARSHIPS

A Number of scholarships are available for the eligible and deserving students. Information regarding dates, eligibility conditions and procedure for applying for these scholarships will be notified on the college notice board from time to time. The students may apply online for these scholarships through online portal <https://scholarships.gov.in/>. The application should be duly attested /verified by the competent authority and should be accompanied by the relevant certificates of Educational Qualification / Income / Category / Domicile/ College Fee Receipt/ Aadhaar No. and Bank Account No., etc. The schemes available at the time of application are subject to the Government notifications.

State Sponsored Scholarship Schemes

- 1. Mukhya Mantri Vidyarthi Kalyan Yojna**-The students who belong to IRDP families may apply for these scholarships with required documents
- 2. Financial Assistance to the children of the armed Forces Personnel Killed/ disabled during the different War/ Operations:** Children of armed force personnel killed/disabled in the different wars/ operations are eligible for the assistance. Application proformas are available with district Sainik Welfare Board.
- 3. Indira Gandhi Utkrisht Chhatravriti Yojna for post plus two students:**
The Indira Gandhi Utkrisht Chhatravriti Yojna for meritorious students for the post plus two courses shall be awarded to 150 students purely on the basis of the merit and without any income ceiling. The Scholarship will also be awarded to ten toppers each from the merit list of 10+2 Arts, Science and Commerce, supplied by H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala, provided they join any academic/ professional stream. The scholarship will be renewed every year to the same number of students till they complete degree/ course.
- 4. Kalpana Chawla Chhatravriti Yojna:**
This is a state sponsored scheme started from the year 2012-13. Under the scheme the top 2000 meritorious girl students of 10+2 of all study groups i.e. Science, Arts and Commerce streams are awarded a scholarship based on passing ratio in each group as per the merit list supplied by HP Board of School Education, Dharamshala. The scholarship will be renewed till the completion of Degree/Diploma/Certificate Course provided there is no failure.

Centrally Sponsored Scholarship Schemes

- 5. Post- Matriculation Scholarship for SC students (H.P.):** For students belonging to SC category whose parents, annual income does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/-
- 6. Post-Matric Scholarship scheme for ST students (H.P.):** For students belonging to ST category whose parents, guardian income from all sources does not exceed 2,50,000/-
- 7. (PM-Yasasvi Post Matric Scholarship For OBC/EBC/DNT Students-Himachal Pradesh):** The students belonging to OBC/EBC/DNT category are entitled for this scholarship if the annual income of their parents is up to Rs. 2,50,000/-.
- 8. Maharishi Balmiki Chatarvriti Yojna:** The scholarship under this scheme is given to the Bonafide Himachali Girls Students belonging to Balmiki Families, engaged in unclean occupation. The concerned students must apply on prescribed proforma through their head of the school/ college/ Institution along with balmiki certificate.
- 9. Merit- Cum means Scholarship for Students belonging to the Minority Community (Centrally Sponsored Scheme):** The annual income of the parents/ guardians of the beneficiaries should not exceed Rs. 2.5 Lakhs from all source and the students should

not have secured less than 55% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination

10. **Post- Matric Scholarship scheme for Students belonging to Minority (Centrally Sponsored Scheme):** Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.
11. **Post matric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities:** This scheme is available to students with disabilities who are covered under the person with disabilities (Equal opportunity, protection of rights and full participation) Act, 1995. Scholarship under the scheme will be awarded by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs, Government of India. Scholarship will be paid to the students whose parents/Guardian's income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/- per annum.
12. **PG Indira Gandhi Scholarship for single girl child:** As per the government guidelines

Fee Concession

Half Fee Concession : One of the two or more real brother/sister studying in the lower class in the college will be eligible for 50% exemption in tuition fee.

Code of Conduct for Students

Students should follow the rules and regulations laid down by the college administration.

1. The Himachal Pradesh Educational Institutions (Prohibition of Ragging) Act, 2009 will be followed in letter and spirit. Indulging in Ragging is a crime and strictly prohibited by an act promulgated by the Government of H.P with the maximum penalty of Rs.50000/- and imprisonment up to three years or both.
2. If any student indulges in any form Eve Teasing inside the college premises or outside, he/she will be dealt as per law.
3. Every student should be dressed up properly.
4. Every student must always carry with him/her duly completed identity card which is issued to him/her at the time of admission. He/she must produce the identity card whenever demanded by Security guard, any Teacher or Principal of the college. In case of loss of Identity Card, a duplicate I-card after a payment of Rs20/ will be issued.
5. Every student has to attend 75% of the classes of each subject/paper.75% of attendance is mandatory for appearing in the annual examination.
6. In case a student is absent in a class continuously for six consecutive days or for 10 days in a month, his /her name will be struck off from the college rolls (In all subjects). Re-admission in such cases will be allowed within a week. For next seven days he/she has to deposit a fine of Rs.100/ for re-admission. After15 days from

the date of struck off, re-admission will be allowed with the representation of the parents, recommendation of the concerned subject teacher and a fine of Rs.500/-.

7. Any student who is unable to appear in the scheduled house test can reappear for the same only on genuine grounds with prior Permission of the Principal.
8. Any other eligible student can reappear for the House Test with recommendation of the concerned course teacher and permission of the Principal. A fine of Rs100/ per paper will be charged and students can reappear within 15 days after the completion of House Exam.
9. Students should not bring outsiders into the campus without the prior permission of the authorities.
10. Sale, distribution, use and possession of banned drugs, alcohol and tobacco products are strictly prohibited and in case of violation shall be dealt with as per law.
11. Fireworks, explosives, weapons, or items of destruction are prohibited in the college campus.
12. Writing on classroom walls, desk, benches, door, toilet wall or pasting of posters on the wall are strictly banned.
13. For Intentional or deliberate damage caused to property (building, furniture, electrical wires/switches/ appliances and sanitary ware etc.), the recovery cost shall be the cost of replacement/repair. It may also be reported to the Police for action as per law.
14. Any damage to lab equipment / articles shall entail fine equal to the cost of equipment.
15. Legal action will be initiated against those who destroy or cause to destroy the property of the college under existing laws including the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act 1984.
16. Students should not create disturbance in the academic, administrative, sporting, social, cultural or other co-curricular activities of the College.
17. Any behaviour falling in the category of sexual harassment at workplace should be reported to the Internal Complaints Committee of the college immediately and the matter would be dealt with as per the Law.
18. Any case of violation of law and order in the college campus will be reported to the police for initiating action against the offenders.
19. Use of Mobile Phone /internet, laptop, and tablet by students within the college campus is permitted at specified places for academic purposes only. Violation of rule will lead to fine of Rs.100/.
20. All other fines will be charged as notified by University from time to time.
21. Misconduct during examination, production of false information or documents for admission purpose and the failure to return materials issued from the college would be seriously dealt with.
22. Gathering in groups at roads, entrance, exit, pathways, corridors and in the administrative block is strictly prohibited. Students who have no class to attend during any particular period should not loiter in the

corridors.

23. All vehicles should be parked in the allotted area. Wrong parking reported by the security guard will be fined Rs.100/.
24. Students can file their genuine complaints to the concerned authority and drop it in the suggestion box placed in the administrative block.
25. Students will appear in the Annual Practical Examination only on scheduled dates as notified by the University.

In general any kind of misconduct towards institute will not be tolerated and punished as per the gravity of the misconduct.

Ragging

“Ragging includes any type of physical or mental torture inflicted by any individual or group, either by words or conduct which creates an apprehension in the mind of the person that he/she cannot pursue his/her studies free from any mental disturbance or torture created thereby. Any person who aids or abet such an action shall also be guilty of such ragging.

Ragging in and around the college/hostel campus or on roads/ approaches leading there to is strictly prohibited. If any student is found indulging in ragging, directly or indirectly, the college authorities shall be obliged under rule 22, 17 (a), (b) & (c) of HP. University to expel the guilty student (s) from the college/hostel.

रैगिंग में किसी भी व्यक्ति या समूह द्वारा शब्द या आचरण से किसी प्रकार के शारीरिक या मानसिक यातना का सामना करना पड़ता है जो व्यक्ति के दिमाग में एक भय पैदा करता है कि वह अपनी पढ़ाई को किसी मानसिक अशांति या अत्याचार के कारण पूरी नहीं कर सकता। ऐसा कोई भी व्यक्ति जो इस प्रकार के कार्यों को प्रत्यक्ष या अप्रत्यक्ष रूप में बढ़ावा देता है या संलिप्त होता है, रैगिंग का दोषी करार दिया जायेगा। महाविद्यालय परिसर में या उसके आस पास के रास्तों या सड़कों पर रैगिंग एक गम्भीर अपराध है और भारत के माननीय सर्वोच्च न्यायालय द्वारा सख्ती से पूर्णरूपेण निषिद्ध है। प्रत्यक्ष या अप्रत्यक्ष रूप से रैगिंग में संलिप्त छात्र/छात्रा को हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय अध्यादेश के नियम 22, 17 (ए), (बी), (सी) के तहत तुरन्त महाविद्यालय से निष्कासित कर दिया जायेगा तथा साथ ही उसे तुरन्त पुलिस को सौंप दिया जायेगा।

LIBRARY

The college has a spacious library which is well ventilated and well illuminated for readers and has more than 12000 books pertaining to various subjects. The college subscribes to various national & international journals of repute.

Timings : 10 am to 4 pm

A. Rules and Regulation

Identity card and library card should be collected from the librarian as per the schedule notified by the librarian. A student must bring his/her library card to get the books issued in his/her name. Only two books are issued to a student at a time for a period of 14 days. Reference Books/Dictionaries/News Papers/Periodicals will not be issued.

If the issued books are not returned by due date, a fine at Rs. 1.00 per book per day will be charged. In case of loss of book, the student will have to replace the book with new one or pay actual price of the book plus 20% of the original prices as a fine amount.

Books returned in damaged condition will entail penalty as per rules. Failure to return the book or to pay the penalty imposed will entail the same procedure for recovery as in the case of recovery of Govt. property i.e. through the police or Deputy Commissioner.

पहचान पत्र व लाईब्ररी कार्ड, पुस्तकालय अध्यक्ष द्वारा जारी समय सारिणी के अनुसार ही प्राप्त किये जाने चाहिए। प्रत्येक छात्र केवल अपने कार्ड पर ही पुस्तकें ले सकता है। एक छात्र को एक समय में केवल दो ही पुस्तकें 14 दिन की अवधि के लिए जारी की जा सकती है। सन्दर्भ पुस्तकें, शब्दकोष, समाचार पत्र व सामयिक पत्रिकाएं विद्यार्थियों को जारी नहीं की जायेगी। यदि जारी की गई पुस्तकों को निर्धारित तिथि में वापिस नहीं किया जाता तो इसके पश्चात प्रतिदिन प्रति पुस्तक पर एक रूपये प्रतिदिन जुर्माना लगाया जाएगा। पुस्तक के खो जाने पर विद्यार्थी को नई पुस्तक खरीद कर देनी होगी अथवा पुस्तक का वास्तविक मूल्य तथा मूल्य के साथ पुस्तक की कीमत का 20 प्रतिशत अतिरिक्त शुल्क जुर्माने के रूप में जमा करना होगा। क्षतिग्रस्त अवस्था में लौटाई गई पुस्तकों पर नियमानुसार जुर्माना लगाया जाएगा। पुस्तकों को वापिस न करना व जुर्माना अदा न करने पर छात्र पर वसूली के लिए पुलिस विभाग व जिलाधीश के माध्यम से वही नियम लागू होंगे जो सरकारी सम्पत्ति की वसूली के लिए लागू होते हैं।

All the issued books must be returned and library card be surrendered to the librarian before the annual examination. A No Dues Certificate to this effect must be obtained from the librarian otherwise Admit Card for Annual Exam will not be issued.

All the student can claim the refund of their library security within one year of leaving the college even if they leave the college without completing their course of study otherwise the security will stand lapsed.

वार्षिक व सत्रांत परीक्षा से पहले छात्रों को जारी की गई सभी पुस्तकों को पुस्तकालय में वापिस किया जाना अनिवार्य है। इस सन्दर्भ में छात्रों को पुस्तकालय अध्यक्ष से एक अदेय प्रमाण पत्र प्राप्त करना होगा अन्यथा छात्र को परीक्षा में बैठने के लिए परीक्षा प्रवेश पत्र जारी नहीं किया जायेगा। महाविद्यालय छोड़ने के पश्चात छात्र को एक वर्ष की अवधि के भीतर अपनी पुस्तकालय धरोहर राशि की वापसी का दावा करना होगा अन्यथा यह धरोहर राशि जब्त समझी जाएगी।

Leave Rules

1. Students should get their leave application recommended by the teachers.
 2. Leave up to 3 days will be sanctioned by the concerned faculty.
 3. Leave for more than three days will be sanctioned by the Principal
 4. The Students will be marked absent during the leave period and the same will not be considered for calculating the lectures attended by him/her for determining his/her eligibility to appear in the University Examination. However in case leave is properly sanctioned, neither his/her name will be struck off from the rolls, nor any absence fine will be imposed.
1. विद्यार्थी को अपनी छुट्टी की अर्जी की संस्तुति/सिफारिश सम्बन्धित अध्यापक से करवानी होगी।
 2. तीन दिन तक के अवकाश की स्वीकृति सम्बन्धित शिक्षक द्वारा दी जाएगी।
 3. तीन दिन से अधिक के अवकाश स्वीकृति केवल प्राचार्य द्वारा ही दी जाएगी।
 4. विश्वविद्यालय की वार्षिक अथवा सत्रांत परीक्षा की पात्रता को निर्धारित करने के लिए विद्यार्थियों की अवकाश अवधि को अनुपस्थिति अवधि माना जायेगा। यद्यपि उचित रूप से स्वीकृत अवकाश के सन्दर्भ में न तो विद्यार्थी का नाम काटा जाएगा तथा ना ही अवकाश अवधि का जुर्माना लगाया जाएगा।

Re-Admission

In case a student is absent in a class continuously for six consecutive days or for 10 days in a month, his /her name will be struck off from the college rolls (In all subjects). Readmission in such cases will be allowed within a week. For next seven days he/she has to deposit a fine of Rs. 100/ for readmission. After 15 days from the date of struck off, readmission will be allowed with the representation of the parents, recommendation of the concerned subject teacher and a fine of Rs. 500/. If the student is absent for 30 days without any information, he/she loses the right to further re-admission. A student can only be re-admitted twice if his/her name is struck off from the college rolls.

यदि कोई छात्र-छात्रा एक महीने में लगातार छ दिनों तक या महीने में 10 दिनों तक कक्षा में अनुपस्थित रहता है, तो उसका नाम महाविद्यालय नामांकन से (सभी विषयों में) काट दिया जाएगा। एक सप्ताह के अंदर पुनः प्रवेश की अनुमति होगी। अगले सात दिनों के अंदर छात्र-छात्रा को 100 रु. जुर्माना देकर पुनः प्रवेश हेतु अनुमति दी जाएगी। नाम कट जाने से 15 दिन बाद पुनः प्रवेश हेतु विद्यार्थी को अपने माता-पिता की उपस्थिति में संबंधित विषय के अध्यापक/अध्यापिका की सिफारिश के साथ पांच सौ रु का जुर्माना देकर ही अनुमति दी जाएगी। यदि छात्र 30 दिनों तक अनुपस्थित रहता है तो वह आगे पुनः प्रवेश का अधिकार खो देता है। यदि छात्र का नाम कॉलेज के रोल से काट दिया गया है तो उसे केवल दो बार ही दोबारा दाखिला दिया जा सकता है।

Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities.

Education is a very broad term and goes beyond the training of one's mind for acquiring textual knowledge. It is associated with other activities in order to see multi-dimensional development of overall

personality of a man. The college provides opportunity to our students through many co-curricular and other activities that help them to develop into a sound body and mind. Keeping this in view we have societies like Science Society, Social Science Society, Red Ribbon Club and ECO Club etc. Students are encouraged to join these societies as per their interest. Students can approach the In-charge of these societies.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

The college has two NSS units. Enrollment in NSS is done in the beginning of the session in the month of August. Students have to apply as and when notified through notice board/college website for enrollment in NSS.

Rovers & Rangers

The College has got two unit of Rovers and Rangers each. Basically it is voluntary non-political youth organization wherein students are trained to combat during natural disaster and otherwise too. It helps its members to have all round development and become perfect responsible individuals to the society, nation and the world at large.

Mentor Cell

The students are encouraged to interact with their teachers regarding their problems which may be academic, non-academic or personal. Appropriate help and guidance is provided to cater the needs of students. It is also an essential and integral part of IQAC.

College Students Central Association (CSCA)

The college student central association is formed every year as per the rules laid down by Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla from time to time. Presently the selection for various post of this association is done through merit i.e. indirect selection mode.

Parent Teacher Association (PTA)

To encourage community participation in education, Parent Teacher Association (PTA) under section 2.33 to 2.33.7 of the HP Education Code, 2001 has been established. It is a non-political body for better co-ordination and interaction between parents and teachers for improvement of academic standards and infrastructural facilities of the college.

The election of the new executive committee of PTA General House is scheduled to be held on 12th August, 2023 at 11.00 am. This is a request from the principal and the staff that the parents are invited to attend this meeting. No separate invitation will be sent in this regard.

IGNOU

IGNOU Study Centre-1133 G.C. Paonta Sahib is running various educational and vocational programmes. All IGNOU courses are recognised by the Govt. of India & by the UGC. The college students can simultaneously do any of the degree or diploma programmes from IGNOU. The additional professional courses under walk-in admission can be done throughout the year in July or January session. No migration and no age limit is required for IGNOU courses.

NCC

The NCC (SW) for girls has been running in the college from the session 2020-21 onwards. The NCC (SD) for boys has been introduced from the session 2023-24.

GCP Alumni Association

The Alumni Association of Government College, Paonta Sahib was formed on 7th October, 2016 and named as "GOVERNMENT COLLEGE PAONTA SAHIB ALUMNI ASSOCIATION (GCPAA) PAONTA SAHIB". GCP Alumni Association is dedicated to bringing together the alumni community on a common platform to build another channel of personal and professional support to members through 'self-help' within the community. GCP Alumni Association membership can be obtained by paying a nominal registration and membership fee. The governing body of the association comprise of the following office bearers:

1. Chief Patron: Principal of the college
2. President, Vice President, Secretary, Joint Secretary, Treasurer, Internal Auditor, Advisor are elected from amongst the alumni.

Self-Financing Courses

Other than routine traditional faculties of Science, Humanities, and Commerce the college offers other important courses including BCA and PGDCA to cater to the needs of technological fast growing society. These self-financing courses are under control of the college level Higher Education Institute Society (Regd.). Presently 50 seats (25 subsidised & 25 Non-subsidised) are there in BCA and PGDCA each.

MBA course is proposed to be started from the session 2024-25. However, the course is subject to the final approval by H.P. University Shimla. For latest updates in this regard, the students are advised to visit the college website time to time.

Graduate Add On Courses

This is a unique initiative of Himachal Pradesh Kaushal Vikas Nigam (HPKVN) to provide an opportunity for final year graduating students to enhance their qualification by pursuing specialized NSQF aligned courses in addition to the regular academic education. The specialized courses not only focus on enhancing the domain knowledge but also involve soft skill at personality development interventions. At present Merchandiser, English Employability & Entrepreneurship (EEE) and social Media Executive courses are being offered in the college without any extra fee.

PAHAL : The CSCA Cultural Function

Preservation of cultural heritage gives strength to the society. The society in turn nurtures cultural programs with gusto. Keeping in view the importance of cultural function, college celebrates cultural festival in the form of a programme called PAHAL with great excitement. This forum provides a platform to students to exhibit their keenness in cultural activities like dancing, singing and various other genres. During this function students prepare cultural items like dancing, singing and various other genres.

Sports

It is a by gone story that studies only bring name. Sports have taken many a strides where one can try for a name and fame. In order to encourage students, the college provides facilities for indoor games. College is housed with a very big playground where Cricket, Volleyball and Basketball courts are well designed. We have facilities for indoor games like Carrom, Chess, and Table Tennis too. Students are encouraged to participate in any of the games and prepare for inter-college tournaments organized by Himachal Pradesh University to earn name and fame and establish oneself in sports also.

BHANUJA : Yearly Periodical

In order to encourage creative abilities among the students, the college magazine "Bhanuja" is published annually. It consists of a number of sections and each section has one staff and one student editor. Students are asked to contribute original authored poems, articles, stories, memoirs, experiences and so on giving it a literary tinge. It also exhibits a panoramic summary of year long activities in the form of pictography.

Duration : The duration of these Master Degree Courses will be of two academic years spread over in four semesters.

Admission procedure for Post Graduate Courses:

The student interested in admission to various PG Courses running in this college (affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University) will have to apply separately [through https://admission.gcp.ac.in](https://admission.gcp.ac.in) in online mode after the declaration of the result of entrance test. The admission will be made strictly on the basis of marks obtained in Entrance test of concerned subject conducted by HP University Shimla.

The minimum qualifying marks in the Entrance test will be 35% to make the candidates eligible for interview/admission. In case of SC/ST candidates, the minimum qualifying marks shall be reduced until the full SC/ST quota for admission has been exhausted.

The Admission/Counselling schedule will be notified on college notice board and website. So student are advised to check the notice board and website regularly.

All the applicants should report for interview/Admission in the college.

In case, some seats remain vacant or fall vacant subsequently, the same will be filled after calling the candidates in order of merit of UG CGPA, only out of the list of the candidates who have been interviewed earlier and were eligible (having passed the qualifying examination on the date of interview).

Eligibility :

The minimum eligibility for admission for postgraduates courses will be 20-24 credits in undergraduate degree course in the concerned subject.

Age Limit :

The upper age limit for post graduate courses is 26 years for boys and 28 years for girls and 29 years in case of SC/ST candidates (both for boys and girls) as on 1st July of the concerned year. Himachal Pradesh University has adopted the age relaxation upto a maximum of 5 years to persons with disabilities in admission to various courses vide UGC letter no. vol-IV Dated 14th September, 2006.

Reservation for various categories will be provided as per University Rules.
