1. Kalpana Chawala Chatravriti Yojna- Himachal Pradesh (Merit Based Scheme)

This scholarship scheme is awarded to top 2000 meritorious girls' students on the basis of merit of Ten Plus Two Examination issued by H.P. School Education Board.

Eligibility.

- a. Must be a Bonafide student of H.P.
- b. Must figure name in the Merit List of Ten Plus Two Examination issued by H.P. School Education Board.

7. Maharishi Balmiki Chatravriti Yojana-Himachal Pradesh (Welfare Based Scheme)

Eligibility

1. The scholarship is applicable to all girls' students belonging to Balmiki families.

1. The student must produce a certificate from the competent authority of Himachal Pradesh for belonging to Balmiki families engaged in unclean occupation.
2. The certificate in respect of working in Unclean Occupation from the Head of Office where the parents are working.

8. National Scholarship for Post Graduate Studies (Merit Based Scheme)

This scholarship scheme is awarded by University Grants Commission (UGC) to 10000 students for two years. The selection under the scheme is done purely on all- India merit basis from among the candidates who have applied for the scholarship under the scheme, through online mode only on the designated portal, i.e., National Scholarship Portal of Government of India.

Eligibility

1. The scholarship is available to the students for the first PG Degree programme only. Students, who have already acquired any postgraduate degree, are not eligible to apply.
2. Only the students, who are already admitted in the first year of PG degree programme are eligible to apply.
3. Only students who are below the age of 30 years of age as on the date of admission in the first semester/year of a PG programme are eligible to apply under these schemes.

9. Post Matric Scholarship For Students With Disabilities (Welfare Based Scheme)

All the components of scholarships are open to students with benchmark disability i.e. 40% or more disability as defined in 'Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016. Further, the applicants should have/possess: a. A valid certificate of disability issued by the competent authority b. Aadhaar based biometric authentication c. Parent income per annum should not exceed Rs.2.5 lakhs.

11. PM-USP – Central Sector Scheme Of Scholarship For College And University Students (CSSS) (Merit Based Scheme)

The scholarships is awarded by Ministry of Education, Government of India on the basis of results of Higher Secondary / Class XII Board Examination.

Eligibility for Scholarship

1. Pursuing regular degree courses

2. Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent;
3. Not availing benefit of any other merit scholarship schemes, State run scholarship schemes, fee waiver, reimbursement scheme.
4. Students with gross parental/family income upto ₹ 4.5 lakh per annum are eligible for scholarship under the scheme. Income certificate will be required only for the fresh applicants;
5. For renewal of scholarship in each year of study, besides getting at least 50% marks in the Annual Examination, maintenance of adequate attendance of at least 75%, will also be the criteria.

12.Financial Assistance for Education to The Wards of Beedi/Cine/Iomc/Lsdm- Post Matric (Welfare Based Scheme)” is 15/10/2026.

Eligibility

1. Either of the parents of the applicant must be a Beedi, Iron Ore, Manganese Ore, Chrome Ore Mines, Limestone, Dolomite Mines, or Cine worker with at least six months of service.
2. The total monthly income of the worker's family must not exceed:
 - 2(a) Beedi Workers: ₹10,000
 - 2(b) Mine Workers:
 - 2(b)(i) Those performing manual, unskilled, highly skilled, and clerical work are eligible irrespective of their wages.
 - 2(b)(ii) Supervisory and managerial employees are eligible if their wages do not exceed ₹10,000 per month.
3. The applicant must have passed the last qualifying examination on the first attempt. Students promoted to the next class are also eligible.
