Feedback	Action Taken
Shortage of classrooms leading to undue extension of timetable and consequent difficulty in catching buses for returning home for rural students.	 New three-storied academic block has been constructed and inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh. Another academic block with a budgetary allocation of ₹ 11.47 crore has been sanctioned and foundation stone laid by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh.
Lack of enough computers in IT lab.	 The second IT lab for BCA/PGDCA has been established with 30 additional computers purchased under Self-Financing Courses. The IT lab for Computer Sciences has been renovated and upgraded with 14 computers. E-resource Centre in the college library has been upgraded with six additional computers.
ICT-enabled classrooms should be increased.	 Cent percent classrooms and seminar halls have been ICT-enabled with Interactive Panels or Digital Podium or Projectors.
High speed internet connectivity should be provided.	 The college has subscribed to 50 Mbps Internet Lease Line incurring an annual expenditure of ₹ 3 lakhs plus GST. The entire academic and administrative infrastructure in college campus has been provided with LAN connectivity.
Organising more educational tours and industrial visits.	 Several educational tours and industrial visits were organised under DBT Star College Scheme of the Government of India for science students. Under Academia-Industry collaborations, industrial visits were organised for other students.
Additional knowledge, more library books, e-resources need to be provided.	 The teachers encouraged students to register themselves for online additional programmes and courses on SWAYAM and Coursera. The teachers encouraged the students to visit e-resource centre for e-content. More library books were purchased for library. Book Bank Scheme for poor students was started.
Need to involve students in project work under different courses.	 Individual and group projects were undertaken as part of skill-based papers in many programmes as part of their curriculum to generate research aptitude.
