a. Rover Rangers: The College has one unit each of Rovers and Rangers, 24 students enrolled in each unit. The unit has continuously participated and organized different activities in the college and also outside the college. 8 Rovers participated in State Level Workshop for Patrol Leaders organized at the state training center, Riwalsar.

b. NSS: The college has two NSS units. Aimed at developing student's personality through community service. the NSS unit of the college has organized various activities like cleanliness drive, competitions, celebration of important days in the college. This unit has also undertaken various extension activities in colorations with the local authorities, Rotary Club, Paonta Sakhi, etc. The Unit has also adopted the pathway at River Yamuna and is helping the local authorities in its maintenance and beautification.

The volunteers are also exceling and are representing the college at state level as well, like volunteer Vipasha has been selected in the Pre-RD selection camp 2021 held at Jaipur. Volunteer Tanvi Sharma has been selected for National Integration Camp at Hisar.

c. NCC: The NCC (SW) unit with 53 cadets has been started for girls' started in session 2020-21. The 14 cadets of the first batch of NCC (SW) went for Annual Training Camp 2021-22 in December 2021 at Eternal University, Baru Sahib. Cadet Tiya Kumari got Gold medal for best drill, Cadet Anjali Rana got Gold medal in solo dance competition. Cadets Sonali and Priyanka Chauhan won bronze medal for poster making competition. Cadet Tiya was selected as the Camp Leader of the camp, and she headed 4 companies of total 388 cadets. All of them appeared for their BEE certificate exam in February 2022.

d. Sports: the college has organized intra-mural kabaddi for men and women during the year. An intracollege Cricket tournament was organized by the college in this year.

4. Steps taken by the institute/ Department/ College/ to improve the quality of education with regard to the following quality parameters of NAAC for the college: -

i. Curricular Aspects:

1. The curriculum delivery was hampered by the COVID-19 pandemic.
2. The affiliating Himachal Pradesh University does not involve the college faculty appropriately in deciding the course curriculum of even undergraduate programmes.
3. New post graduate courses have been started in the college. Four more PG courses have been announced by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh which are likely to begin from the next session.
4. The college may utilize the collaboration with Himachal Pradesh Kaushal Vikas Nigam for running skill-based add-on courses for the students.
5. The college has successfully organized 16 add-on courses under IGNOU and funded under Utkrisht Mahavidyalay Yojana in this session.
6. The industrial academia collaboration provides the opportunities to the students for experiential learning.

ii. Teaching-Learning & Evaluation:

1. Being a government institution, a large number of students come from rural backward areas and due to less exposure, they face difficulties in adjusting to the pace of higher education.
2. The launch of National Education Policy 2020 will further strengthen the Outcome Based Education (OBE) system.
3. Participative learning methodologies are encouraged with stakeholders' views given greater priorities.

4. The mentor-mentee may be further strengthened by incorporating the services of professional counsellors and psychologists.
5. The annual student satisfaction survey provides insight into the impact of the delivery of education.

iii. Research, consultancy & Extension:

1. The NCC unit with 53 cadets has been started for girls.
2. The extension activities by NSS, Rovers & Rangers, Eco Club, Red Ribbon Club and NCC have increased with the waning of the impact of Corona.
3. Academia-industry collaborations have been established. The collaborations with other academic institution in the Sirmour district have also been set up. But there is a huge scope for further strengthening these collaborations.
4. The faculty is low in motivation to conduct research.
5. The student research is being encouraged. 137 research projects were prepared by the students under Utkrisht Mahavidyalay Yojana

iv. Infrastructure and Learning Resources:

1. The college infrastructure is provided by the state government and a new block with a budgetary allocation of 11.47 crore shall strengthen the infrastructure.
2. Indoor stadium is proposed to be constructed from RUSA Grant.
3. Gym trainer and coach for some games is proposed to be appointed on permanent basis.
4. Science Labs have been upgraded under DBT Star College Scheme.
5. ICT infrastructure has recently been strengthened and updated through Utkrisht Mahavidyalay Yojana.
6. Library needs to be provided with more books, journals, and e-resources.
7. The college has 100% Smart Classrooms equipped with interactive panels and LAN connection with 50MBPS internet connection. The college library of the college is fully automated and has e-resource center with 6 computer systems and LAN connection.

1. Provision for coaching for competitive examination should be provided regularly.
2. The girl students belonging to Himachal Pradesh are provided tuition freeship.
3. The college has been doing well in football and hockey tournaments at the state level.
