The meeting began with the point-wise review of the recommendations of previous meeting and the action taken so far regarding these recommendations.

Action Taken

1. The different committees for the accomplishment of different works approved under RUSA Grant have been constituted and the process has been initiated after observing all codal formalities.
2. The renovation of multi-purpose hall has partially been completed with PVC wall panelling and the remaining task of installing electronic appliances is under process which is likely to be completed by the end of the session.
3. Two commercial RO system have been purchased and installed.
4. Iron benches for sitting have been purchased and installed at different appropriate places for the students in the campus.
5. Three special sessions of career counselling have been organized by the career counselling cell/ job placement cell of the college i.e.
 - (a) Rojgar mela in collaboration with Jio-Infocom Pvt. on 08/02/2019 in which 80 students participated.
 - (b) Special session on Civil Services Examination preparation was organized on 20/02/2019 with participation of about 250 students and teachers. A team of Chanakya IAS Academy Chandigarh was invited for the purpose.
 - (c) Special Inter-Faculty Career Counselling session organized on 21/02/2019, in which 200 outgoing students of 6th semester participated. The students were made aware of the career opportunities in their respective discipline of study.

6. The AQAR for the session 2017-18 has been successfully submitted to NAAC on 24/12/2018 after reviewing and discussing all the data pertaining to the different criteria of AQAR.
7. For the complete renovation of college playground, the estimates from HPPWD have been obtained and the required amount has been transferred to HPPWD. The work will be assigned by HPPWD through the process of e-tendering.

Recommendations and Suggestions:

1. Since the renovation work of multi-purpose hall is in the process, therefore the existing seating furniture/chairs of MPH may be replaced with the equivalent number of good quality, single seater wooden desks for the hassle free conduct of examination and to organize the Intra-College Functions.
2. The access of digitized/online study support material should be provided to the college student. Therefore, a new digital computer lab may be established with approximately, 30 computers systems with proper seating arrangement.
3. The purchase and installation of Generator set is recommended to be purchased and installed by the end of this session.
4. The provision of emergency First Aid/Sick room may be made.
5. For the hassle-free functioning of the post-graduate classes of Economics, Hindi, English and Commerce, an independent separate block for post-graduate courses may be constructed as per the master plan.
6. The new courses of B.B.A .and B.Sc. in Computer Science may be introduced in the college and for their necessary formalities and correspondence may be initiated at the earliest.
7. The GCP Alumni Association may be further strengthened by organizing the general house of alumni.
8. The financial Lab cum incubation centre may be established at the earliest.
9. The installation of white board (in all classrooms), which is already in the process may be completed at the earliest.


Recommendations and Suggestions :-



- 2) The access of digitized/ ^{online} study support material should be provided to the college students. Therefore a new digital computer lab may be established with approximately 30 computer systems with proper seating arrangement.
- 3) Since the construction of New Students' Common Room is not feasible in view of the ongoing construction work of new building, therefore as a part-time substitute of common room, the designed sheds with proper iron sitting benches may be established at appropriate places in the campus.
- 4) The provision of Emergency First Aid/ Sick Room may be made.
- 5) For the hassle free functioning/summing up of the Post-graduate classes Economics, Hindi, English

and Commerce, an Independent & separate block for post-graduate Courses may be constructed at appropriate place so that the aesthetic of College building/Campus is not spoiled.

- 6) The new courses of BBA and BSc in Computer Science may be introduced in the college and for their necessary formalities & correspondence may be initiated at the earliest.
- 7) The GCP Alumni Association may be further strengthened by organising the General house of alumni.
- 8) The Financial Lab cum Incubation Centre may be established at the earliest.
- 9) The installation of white board (in all class room), which is already in the process, may be completed at the earliest.
