J. Arbitration Clause

Should there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principal, Shree Guru Gobind Singh Ji Government College Paonta Sahib and Principal, Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government Post Graduate College, Nahan will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.
