

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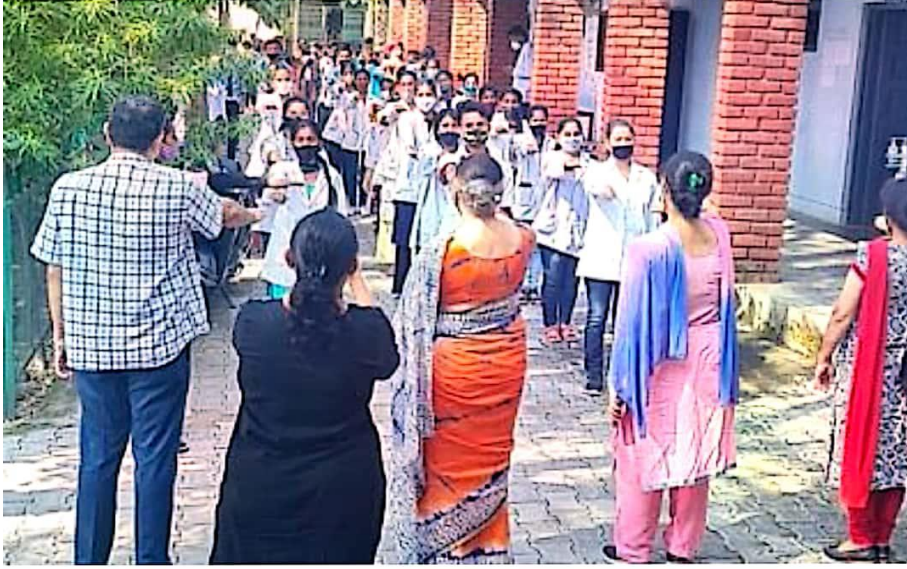

### 6. SEMINAR ON EVE TEASING ON 27.10.2021

On 27th October 2021 a lecture on Protection from Eve Teasing was organized by Women Development Cell of Shri Guru Govind Singh Ji Government Degree College, Paonta Sahib. Dr. Veena Rathore, Principal Shri Guru Govind Singh Ji Government Degree College, Paonta Sahib graced the occasion as the Chief Guest. Prof. Bharti, Assistant Professor in Physical Education and Sanjeev Kumar Legal Advisor (NALSA) were the resource persons of the programme. Dr. Ritu Pant, convenor of Women Development Cell welcomed the resource persons Prof. Bharti, Sanjeev Kumar Legal Advisor (NALSA) other dignitaries, teachers and participants.

Dr. Veena Rathore, Principal Shri Guru Govind Singh Ji Government Degree College, Paonta Sahib made the girls aware about the term Eve Teasing. She said that teasing girls and women, passing audible comment on them, harassing them verbally or physically, and troubling them purposely is all called 'eve teasing'. She focused on the fact that gone are the days when women live in silence now the time has changed and women have made themselves strong enough and now women need not and should not suffer in silence when they are victims of eve teasing, they should promptly report it.

The resource person Professor Bharti in Physical Education told that Eve-teasing is a traumatic experience for women. It can leave deep psychological scars which can be hard to heal. Eve-teasing has resulted into many unfortunate events in the lives of women. Sometimes, it has made parents keeping their daughters at home away from school or marrying them off at an early age. Ironically, Eve teasing has dangerous consequences for women and not for men as it can deprive them of their freedom, nutrition and education.

Most often the incident of Eve-teasing is blamed on the victims, i.e. women. It is as if males have got license to indulge in any sort of lecherous behaviour and can go away with it. The patriarchal nature of our society has not been able to deal with incidents of Eve-teasing in right perspective. There have been plenty of instances when women have come out in open sharing their experiences. Different newspapers and websites keep publishing such accounts that reflect feelings of disgust, insult and scare experienced by women. No one can explain the truth of eve-teasing and sexual harassment better than the female who gave gone through it.


  
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Sanjeev Kumar, Legal Advisor (NALSA) discussed in details about the Articles\sections from the protection of Eve Teasing. He told the girls students that Article 294 IPC [vi] states three months of imprisonment or fine or both if one finds in guilty of eve teasing. Under Section 298 A and Section 298 B of the Indian Penal Code, a man who is found guilty of making a female the target of obscene gestures, remarks, songs or recitation, can be can be imprisoned for three months. Under Section 292, if a man shows pornographic or obscene pictures, books to a female, he will be fined a sum of Rs.2000 with two years of rigorous imprisonment, if the offence has been committed for the first time. In the event of a repeated offence, the guilty will be fined with Rs.5000 and spend five year in prison. Section 354 imposes a two-year imprisonment with a fine when a person is found guilty of assault or using criminal force on a woman with intent to outrage modesty. Section 509 punishes the "intent to insult the modesty of any woman by use of words, sounds, gestures, or the exhibition of any object in such a way as to intrude upon the privacy of a woman" with a fine and one year in prison. In the end Prof. Seema Tyagi offered vote of thanks. The programme was ended with National Anthem. Total 103 Girls students were present in the programme.

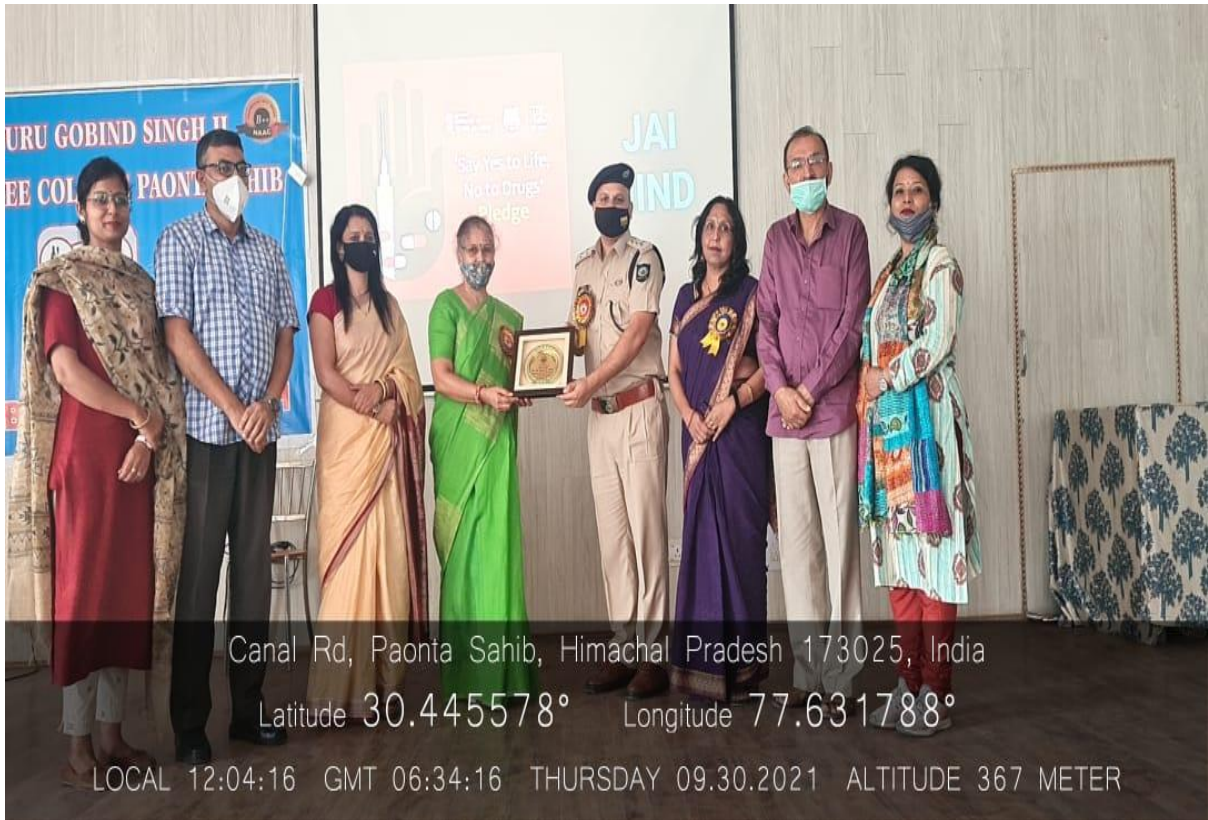
### 7. AWARENESS ON DRUG ABUSE AMONG YOUTH ON 30.09.2021

A talk on Drug Abuse Among Youth was organized by Life Skills Committee of Shri Guru Govind Singh Ji Government Degree College, Paonta Sahib on 30th September 2021. Dr. Veena Rathore, Principal, Shri Guru Govind Singh Ji Government Degree College, Paonta Sahib, graced the occasion as the esteemed Chief Guest. Shri Bir bahadur, Sub-Divisional Police Officer, Paonta Sahib was the resource person of the programme. The programme was inaugurated by lighting up the lamp by the chief guest, resource person, the convenor of the committee and the senior professors of the college. The honourable Principal of the college welcomed the revered resource person Shri Bir bahadur, DSP Paonta Sahib other dignitaries, teachers and participants. The esteemed Chief Guest, in her address, urged the students that drug addiction is very harmful, it not only destroys health but also leave negative influence on the psyche of the user. Drug abuse among youth increases the risk of problems related to their well-being and health, resulting in an increased risk of injury and death from interpersonal violence and road accidents. The resource person, Shri Birbahadur ji, DSP Paonta Sahib, spoke about synthetic drugs and discussed how youth get into drugs due to reasons such as addiction, peer pressure, problems faced by youth. He spoke about the steps taken by Paonta Police to curb the drug use in the city. He requested the students to not get into drugs because its repercussions ruin the youth life completely. He spoke from a student's perspective and addressed how a good percentage of youth have been addicted to drugs and how it destroys students' lives. Prof. Vimmi Rani, the convenor of Life Skills Committee focused on the fact that the relationship between a parent and their child has a unique bond that nurtures the holistic growth and development of a child. She apprised the audience that parents play a major role in helping their children if they have initiated the use of drugs. Talking with children about the dangers of drug use and showing disapproval of such behaviour is a key to shaping children's attitudes and behaviours. In the end Prof. Bharti offered vote of thanks. ### GUIDELINES FOR USING ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES

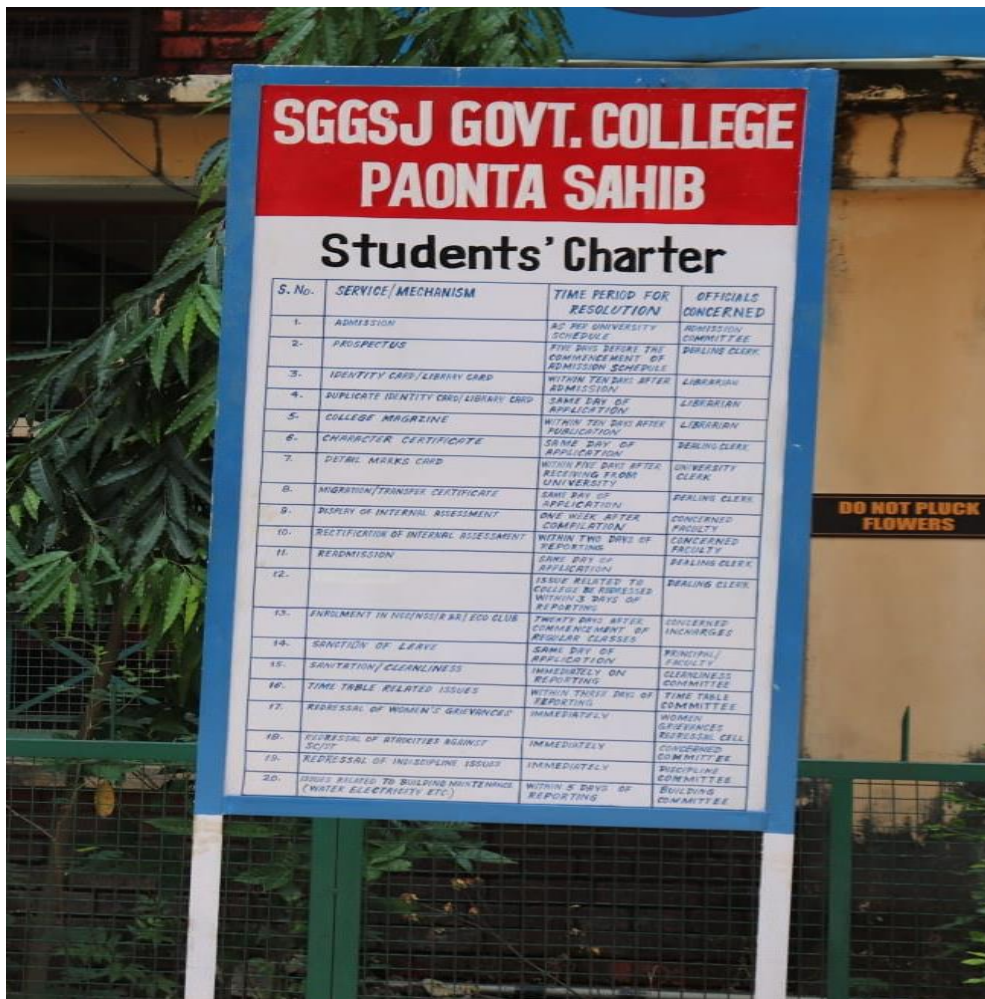
1. Switch off all the appliances when they are not in use.

## 10. AWARENESS ON FIRE SAFETY ON 22.10.2021

### 10. AWARENESS ON FIRE SAFETY ON 22.10.2021

Under the guidance of College Disaster Management Cell, the Fire Safety Awareness Committee of Shri Guru Gobind Singh Ji Government College, Paonta Sahib organized a lecture on "Fire Safety Awareness" on 22nd October, 2021 in the college premises. Prof. Ritu Pant (Officiating Principal) was the Chief Guest and Shri Shivanand Sharma, Retired Fire Station Officer was the keynote speaker of the program. The program started with a warm welcome by the committee convener Prof. Kamlesh Sharma. He apprised all the audience with the outline of the programme. Thereafter, Prof. Ritu Pant addressed the students and gave a message that at the time of any kind of disaster, information is the only defence. She said that although disasters do not come pre-intimated but one should always be prepared for them. She urged the students to pay heed to the highly informative lecture and assured them that it will be beneficial for them to understand the ways that can be used to confront any disaster without panic. She also congratulated the Fire Safety Awareness team for organizing such highly beneficial programme.

Shri Shivanand Sharma, the keynote speaker delivered his talk by informing the audience that there are two types of disasters, natural and man-made and fire accidents mainly come under man-made disasters. He told the students about the triangle of fire which requires mainly three things: fuel, heat and oxygen and emphasized that this triangle should never be completed so that any calamity due to fire can be avoided. He further classified fire into classes A, B, C, D, E, F on the basis of sources of ignitions and informed about the various types of fire extinguishers such as water, foam, powder, carbon dioxide, blanket etc. that can be used accordingly. He stressed on the importance of a Fire Alarm. He said that presence of mind is most important at the time of any such mishappening and we should be well aware of the ways in which fire can be stopped. He apprised the students with the importance of a fireman who risks his own life for the safety of others. He concluded by saying that we cannot prevent disasters but we can control them and with our awareness we can save ourselves and other's lives as well. Prof. Sushil Tomar concluded the program by extending a formal vote of thanks.

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

### 13. AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON SEXUAL HARASSMENT OF WOMEN AT WORKPLACE

A lecture on the sexual harassment of women at workplace was organised in room number 101 on 07/12/21. Prof. Pooja Bhati invited the convenor of the Internal Complaints Committee Prof. Vimmi Rani to deliver the lecture. The program started with Badge pinning of Dr Mohan Singh Chief Guest Officiating Principal and Prof. Devindra Gupta (Special Guest and external member of Internal Committee). Prof. Vimmi Rani stated that Supreme Court of India in case of Vishakha vs State of Rajasthan has reaffirmed that Sexual harassment is a form of discrimination against women and violates the constitutional Right to Equality, Life, and Liberty. With more and more women joining workforce, ensuring an enabling working environment for women through legislation has been held imperative by the government. The Act contains provisions to protect every woman from any act of sexual harassment at workplace by fixing the responsibility on the employer as well as District or Additional District Magistrate or the Collector or Deputy Collector of every district in the state and by laying down a statutory redressal mechanism. Sexual harassment-includes any of the unwelcome acts or behaviour namely – 1 Physical contact or advances or 2 A demand or request for sexual favours or 3 Making sexually coloured remarks or 4 Showing pornography 5 Any other unwelcome physical, verbal or nonverbal conduct of sexual nature. Further she explained in detail about the meaning of prevention of sexual harassment, aggrieved woman, respondent, employee, employer, chairperson, Domestic worker etc. Then she explained about the constitution of the Internal Complaint Committee and Local complaint committee. She also focused upon how the complaint of the sexual harassment can be made and how conciliation can be reached between the aggrieved woman and the respondent. She also explained about how inquiry into complaint made by the aggrieved woman be conducted by the internal committee and how committee can determine compensation to the aggrieved woman. She also explained about the prohibition of publication or making public contents of complaint and inquiry proceedings. She concluded her lecture by explaining the duties of employer with regard to safe working environment at the workplace. The lecture ended with a vote of thanks offered by Prof. Vimmi Rani. The lecture was attended by 146 students.
