## Results of Analysis of Employer's Feedback Regarding Curriculum Academic Session 2020-21

Employers are the end beneficiaries of the course curriculum. Feedback from the employers helps to incorporate recent trends and emerging concept in the curriculum. Keeping this importance in view feedback from them were invited to know the effectiveness of the curriculum.

#### Methodology

The curriculum feedback from employers has been collected through structured questionnaire, which includes 11 questions on various aspects of curriculum. 27 responses of employer's feedback forms on curriculum have been received on different papers taught by them. A Five Point Likert Scale has been used with weights assigned from 1 to 5 to different levels as follows:

1= Strongly Disagree/ Highly Dissatisfied/ Lack

2= Disagree/ Dissatisfied/ Inadequate

3= Neutral / No Opinion/ Average

4= Agree/ Satisfied / Adequate

5 = Strongly Agree/ Highly Satisfied/ Abundance

The range of each level is determined by the following formula:

Highest point on Likert Scale- Lowest Point on Likert Scale)/Number of Levels used

Therefore: Range=  $(5-1)/5 \Rightarrow 4/5 \Rightarrow 0.8$ 

Hence,

Range for "Strongly Disagree/ Highly Dissatisfied/ Lack" is	1.0 to 1.8
Range for "Disagree/ Dissatisfied/ Inadequate" is	1.8 to 2.6
Range for "Neutral / No Opinion/ Average" is	2.6 to 3.4
Range for "Agree/ Satisfied / Adequate" is	3.4 to 4.2
Range for "Strongly Agree/ Highly Satisfied/ Abundance" is	4.2 to 5.0

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

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
Graph displays the responses received for question in terms of percentage.

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
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4. The curriculum enhances the inclination to adopt new methods, technology, and workplace equipment



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
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6.The curriculum promotes leadership qualities and problem-solving abilities

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

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



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curriculum ensures professional ethics.



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

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
