## Introduction

Shree Guru Gobind Singh Ji Government College Paonta Sahib underwent the 1<sup>st</sup> Cycle of NAAC accreditation in May 2017. The college was accredited on 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2017 with B++ Grade with a CGPA of 2.79 on four-point scale. The next cycle of accreditation is due in May 2022.

The college, by virtue of its inherent advantages and achievements in many respects, is naturally entitled to a higher score by any standards. But it requires concerted efforts from the stakeholders in mainstreaming the given facilities and services towards the ultimate goal of excellence in higher education. Therefore, an agenda is put forward for serious discussions and effective implementation.

The college was bestowed with the prestigious "Star College" status by the Department of Biotechnology, Government of India, in recognition of the advancements made by the college in the field of science education, with a handsome financial grant.

## NAAC Accreditation Criteria-wise Strategic Goals

## 1. Strategic Goals - Criteria 1: Curricular Aspects

## i. Starting of new Post Graduate Courses in the College

The college envisions starting of Post Graduate courses in certain subjects of interest of large number of students in and around Paonta Sahib so that higher education after graduation does not witness a dropout especially for the poor but meritorious ones who will receive post-graduation education at doorstep. The college proposes to start Master of Arts (M.A.) in Political Science, Geography, Hindi, History; and Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Chemistry and Mathematics after seeking prior approval of the Government of Himachal Pradesh.

## ii. Starting Add-on Certificate Courses with 50% Student Enrolment Target

Paonta Sahib being an industrial area, makes it indispensable for students to sharpen their job-oriented skills. Hence the college plans to run certain add-on certificate courses particularly in computers, training in financial accounting software, communicative skills, etc. The target would be to make 50% of total college enrolment skilled.

## iii. Online Curriculum Feedback

The college considers feedback as a significant tool to remove the shortcomings in the curriculum being taught. Hence the college looks forward to designing of such online feedback forms to collect from stakeholders and provide an upper edge to the students of Government College Paonta Sahib over others. A google form with a well-researched questionnaire shall be structured and shared with the stake holders.



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## iv. Encouraging Student Research Projects, Internships, and Field Works

The college plans to encourage students towards building of research aptitude and temperament inside them by not only guiding them in research works but also providing them financial support to meet the expenses in collection of data and its presentations.

## 2. Strategic Goals - Criteria 2: Teaching- Learning and Evaluation

### i. Identification of Learning Levels of Students

Our college plans to enhance its imparting of quality education by focusing on students as per their learning levels and requirements. This plan is to conduct objective multiple-choicequestions-based test in their respective courses and then identify the levels of learning. This will help the teachers to restructure the teaching methods accordingly and effectively both in and outside class.

## ii. Preparation and Dissemination of Programme and Course Outcomes

The college shall continue to improvise on the outcomes of programmes and courses so that multidimensional results are achieved in the intellectual and holistic growth of the students. The college plans to make each and every student comprehend the parameters which he/she should imbibe by the completion of the course.

## iii. Encouraging Student-Centric Teaching-Learning Process

There shall be encouragement to the use of student-centric teaching learning methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning, and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences of the students. The college plans to conduct various workshops, role-play methodologies such as moot parliament, seminars, groups discussions, etc. on various themes and topics.

## iv. Developing Transparency in the Internal Assessment Mechanism

The college has always been transparent and judicious in awarding assessment marks to the students. This mechanism shall be strengthened further with sharing the marks and criteria after granting all chances to improve the performance by the students. The college plans to share all the lists of assessment evaluation on class and notice boards and get the list of awards signed by the students.

#### v. Examination-related Grievance Redressal Mechanism

Developing strong and effective mechanism for redressal of grievances related to internal/external examinations is mandatory. Hence the college plans to have a committee for redressal of such grievances which shall develop a route so that exact cause of the grievance is identified and hence resolved in a transparent, time-bound and efficient manner.



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## vi. Improvement of Academic Results

The college plans to get better academic results by introducing the learning level tests for students other than internal examinations and assignments as quality initiative. The access to e-resources, increase in the library timings, setting up of book bank etc. shall improve academic results.

## vii. Strengthening Mentor-Mentee System

The college has strategically planned to organise student counselling through mentors and plans to divide the students into groups of 50 to 60 under each mentor with each group having students from different classes and subjects.

## viii. Conducting Annual Student Satisfaction Survey

The college plans to conduct annual student satisfaction survey to evaluate student satisfaction effectively through a google form for their feedback. The analysis of the survey data shall help the college to formulate introduction of new and better facilities for students; also to identify, address and resolve their common problems.

## 3. Strategic Goals - Criteria 3: Research, Innovations and Extension

## i. Promotion of Research Culture in the Institution

The institution shall conduct seminars and conferences at regional, state, and national levels to provide exposure to students as well as faculty to promote research culture. The institution shall explore funding opportunities for projects, seminars, workshops for research promotion. The research infrastructure shall be upgraded and strengthened by providing hi-tech ICT facilities, research data analysis software, e-resources, etc.

## ii. Starting of NCC Unit in the College

College plans to take up the process of starting of NCC Unit of both girls and boys with NCC Central office as recommended by the Peer Team Report of the 1<sup>st</sup> Cycle of Accreditation.

## iii. Encouraging Extension Activities

The extension activities shall involve the community of the area. Visits of members of various clubs and societies to nearby areas especially slums and rural areas to create awareness, organise cleanliness drives etc. shall be organised.

## iv. Establishing Collaborations with Industries and Other Institutions

The collaborations with industries and other institutions shall be established and memorandums of understanding shall be signed with them. Different activities such as expert talks on latest technology and skills by industry personnel, industrial visits of students, academia-industry interactive seminars, CSR initiatives financial grants to be invested in the college for both infrastructure and teaching-learning shall be emphasised.



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## 4. Strategic Goals - Criteria 4: Infrastructure and Learning Resources

## i. Construction of New Academic Block:

The Government of Himachal Pradesh has sanctioned and allocated the budget for construction of a new academic block and the foundation stone has been laid and the construction work has started. The college shall follow-up the construction work and get it done well in time by the year 2021.

## ii. Arts and Commerce Academic Block

The college requires more of classrooms and other infrastructure for the smooth functioning of both Undergraduate and Postgraduate classes. The college shall take up the matter of sanction of another academic block for Arts and Commerce with the Government of Himachal Pradesh.

## iii. Campus Beautification:

The college plans to beautify the premises by constructing the sheds in pagoda style near the botanical garden. The college also plans to tile the open compound between the administrative and academic blocks. The Campus Beautification committee shall do the needful for plantations, maintenance, development and shaping of plants, undergrowth, and trees in the campus.

## iv. Sufficient Signboards in the campus

The college shall fix the layout map of the college campus, along with appropriate signboards for the information and convenience of students and visitors.

#### v. Solar Lights in the campus

The college shall install solar lights in college campus as it is environment friendly and green energy source.

#### vi. Renovation of Canteen

The college shall arrange better facilities in College Canteen in terms of food and hygiene, renovation of Atal students' corner and improving sitting arrangements.

## vii. Naming of Building Blocks and other Physical Infrastructure

The college shall name the students corner, library, various blocks and other college infrastructure after great men of the soil.



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## viii. Setting up of an Indoor as well as Outdoor Gymnasium

The college shall improve indoor gymkhana and also establish outdoor gym for physical fitness of students and players.

## ix. Library Automation

The college plans to automate the library so that access, location, and issue of books become easy and automatic. The books-self-issue-return kiosk shall be installed in the library.

## x. More books and Journals for the Library

The college plans to update the library with latest publications in all courses alongwith subscriptions for journals online and offline both. The book bank scheme shall be made functional for providing textbooks to the students for the entire academic session.

#### xi. E-Resources Centre in the Library

The college shall purchase more of computers for e-resource centre in the library. Subscription of inflibnet and other e-resources shall be purchased for the institution.

## xii. Smart Classrooms

The college shall make 100% classrooms and seminar halls ICT enabled and encourage the teachers and students to use ICT teaching aids extensively.

## xiii. Upgradation of IT Labs

The college shall upgrade the IT lab by purchasing new computers and replacing obsolete computers and software. The required physical infrastructure including air conditioning system, furniture, inverter, online UPS etc. shall also be set up to make a hi-tech lab.

## xiv. Internet Least Line with appropriate Bandwidth

The college shall subscribe to internet lease line with appropriate bandwidth and set up campus wide local area networking as per the needs of ICT facilities in the college in the near future.

## xv. Maintenance of College Infrastructure, Whitewashing of Building etc.

The college shall regularly get the college building repaired and whitewashed through authorised government agency HPPWD to maintain the infrastructure.



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## 5. Strategic Goals - Criteria 5: Student Support and Progression

## i. Capacity Building and Skill Enhancement Initiatives

The college shall conduct seminars, workshops, trainings and lectures on soft skills, language and communication skills, life skills including Yoga, physical fitness, health and hygiene, and ICT & Computing skills.

## ii. Coaching for Ground Test for Army/Police/Forest Positions

Keeping in view the interest of students to join army, police and forest department, the college shall coach the students in the college ground free of cost for ground/physical test by engaging an expert trainer.

## iii. Coaching for Civil Service Examinations

The college shall also provide free coaching for administrative examinations advertised by the state as well as Union Public Service Commission and sub-ordinate service boards also by engaging some reputed coaching institution.

## iv. Organising Rojgar Mela

Our college being located in an industrial town shall organise rojgar mela for placement of students in industries of their choice.

## v. Developing Mechanism for Tracking Student Progression

The college shall utilise the potential of social media in tracking student progression by making WhatsApp group and Facebook. The college shall give thrust to organising of alumni meets, alumni-student interactions, alumni engagement as invited speakers and their active participation in college functions.

## vi. Encouraging participation in Sports and Cultural Competitions

The college has always and shall in near future encourage participation in sports and cultural competitions by strengthening the existing infrastructure. The college shall also organise more of intra-college competitions in both fields to provide larger number of students a chance to display their talent.

## 6. Strategic Goals - Criteria 6: Governance, Leadership and Management

## i. Use and Implementation of E-Governance Initiatives of Government
