Observations

- Result analysis of students for identification of learning levels and implementation of separate programmes for slow and advanced learners.
- 4. Transparency and fairness in admission process and reservation to weaker sections provided in admission.
- 5. Transparent internal evaluation system.
- 6. No faculty development programmes organised by the college.
- 7. Low footfalls in library.
- 8. Industrial visits and educational tours organised for the students.
- 9. Significant initiatives taken for green campus.
- 10. Polybricks as management of solid plastic waste.
- 11. Library needs upgradation and automation.
- 12. Research papers and books by faculty are lacking.
- 13. Research fund mobilisation is lacking.
- 14. Less number of seminars and workshops organised.
- 15. Well-managed and effective NSS units.
- 16. IQAC constituted as per NAAC norms.
- 17. Rotation policy is a good initiative providing opportunities to different faculties and staff members.
- 18. None of the college faculty is registered as a research guide.
- 19. Outcome based education (OBE) model followed in the college with defined programme and course outcomes and their attainment measurement.
- 20. The college has a sufficient playground with appropriate sitting steps along the boundary.
- 21. The college has established academia-industry collaborations.
- 22. The college does not have a functional and effective system of placement of student.
- 23. The college has a well-established mentor-mentee system.
- 24. The institution conducts gender, environment, and green audit.

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Recommendations

- Increase the number of teachers attending professional development programmes, viz., Orientation Programme, Refresher Course, Short Term Course, Faculty Development Programmes during the year.
- 2. Activities on Gender Equity be increased.
- 3. Incubation centre be created, and start-ups be incubated on campus
- 4. Institution may make efforts for adding more Value-added add-on certificate courses imparting transferable and life skills in the forthcoming years
- 5. More field Projects / Internships may be encouraged to undertake
- Efforts may be made by the faculty for recognition for more awards, recognition, fellowships at State, National, International level from Government, recognized bodies.
- 7. Efforts may be made by the faculty to have research funds (sanctioned /received) from various agencies, industry, and other organizations.
- 8. Workshops/Seminars may be conducted on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and Industry-Academia Innovative practices.
- Number of Collaborative activities for research, faculty exchange, student exchange be enhanced.
- Institution may make its best efforts to have MoUs with institutions of national, international importance, other universities, colleges, industries, corporate houses.
- 11. Efforts may be made by the faculty to design e-content such as: e-PGPathshala, SWAYAM, other MOOCs platform NPTEL/NMEICT/any other Government initiatives & institutional (Learning Management System LMS) etc.
- 12. Teachers may be provided with financial support to attend conferences / workshops.
- 13. Career counselling and placement cell needs to be strengthened with a full-fledged placement officer and more activities like rojgar mela be conducted.
- 14. The college should have an indoor stadium.
- 15. More ICT enabled classrooms to be provided.
- 16. More collaboration be encouraged and more MoUs be signed.
- 17. Students should be encouraged to get books issued from college library.
- 18. The college needs to put in efforts to improve the passing percentage.

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- 19. More Post Graduate Courses should be started in the College.
- 20. The college needs to upgrade the college gymnasium.
- 21. Provision of Girls and Boys hostels to be provided.
- 22. Introduction of NCC Boys unit be started.
